How do I Register for the TEAS Exam?

All individuals preparing to take the TEAS exam must create an ATI account. Create an account by going to ATI's website at <http://www.atitesting.com>. Click on "Create Account" and follow the screen prompts. Click on "How to Register for the TEAS" for step-by-step instructions. You only need to register once.

Please Note: You will need your ATI username and password to take the online test. Please bring this information with you to the testing location on your exam date.

If you are not completing the TEAS exam in person at Western Technical College, please request an official TEAS transcript from ATI be sent to Western Technical College in La Crosse, WI. See below for further information on requesting a transcript. There is a fee paid through your ATI account to have your transcript sent to Western.

- Log into your ATI TEAS account.
- Click My Results tab.
- Click on Share Transcript and Select the Institution (**Western Technical College, La Crosse, Wisconsin**).

What should I bring to the exam session?

- A photo ID
- Your ATI username and password

It is important to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the exam time. The testing session starts promptly with 15-20 minutes of pre-testing instructions and registration.

Please Note: Students may not be admitted once the session starts.
