How to apply for **CREDIT** courses

Emergency Medical Technician (EMR-EMT Part 1 AND EMT Part 2)

In order to be eligible for an EMT License you will need to complete BOTH EMR/EMT Part 1 AND EMT Part 2 courses.

How To Apply:

1. Submit an application at www.westerntc.edu/apply. Choose “Enroll in a Program” and select the EMT program which is found under the “Public Safety” interest area on the application. Choose “EMT full program” (\$30)
2. Complete a [background check](#) via ViewPoint Screening (\$48)
3. Read, Sign and Return the following forms to admissions@westerntc.edu
 - a. [Technical Standards Form](#)
 - b. [Supplemental Information Form](#)

Please note: a 2 Step TB test series (2 separate skin tests) and immunization requirements will need to be submitted to ViewPoint Screening Health Portal (\$20) before the EMT-Part 2 course begins.

EMT- Part 2 (Offered during Spring Term)

This course builds upon the EMR course. Once completed, candidates will be eligible to participate in the National Registry of EMT Exam. If you have taken EMR/EMT Part 1 or currently hold an EMR License, you will need to complete the application process listed below:

How To Apply:

1. Submit an application at www.westerntc.edu/apply. Choose “Enroll in a Program” and select the EMT program which is found under the “Public Safety” interest area on the application. Choose “EMT-Part 2” program level (\$30)
2. Complete a [background check](#) via ViewPoint Screening (\$48)
3. Read, Sign and Return the following to admissions@westerntc.edu
 - a. [Technical Standards Form](#)
 - b. [Supplemental Information Form](#)
 - c. Current BLS Provider Card
 - d. Current WI EMR License or documented course completion (official transcripts) within the last 24 months from a WTCS program.
4. Complete a 2 Step TB test series (2 separate skin tests) with your healthcare provider
5. Upload 2 Step TB Testing results, and all other immunizations to [ViewPoint Screening Health Portal](#) (\$20)

AEMT (Offered 1 Time per Year)

Critical Care Transport – Paramedic

1. Submit an application at www.westerntc.edu/apply. Choose “Just take a course or two” after login, and indicate you are interested in the Critical Care Transport course.
