Program Goal

The EMT Basic course emphasizes the development of student skills in patient assessment and examination, the recognition of signs and symptoms of illness and injury, and the use of proper procedures when rendering basic emergency care.

National Registry Examination Statistics

Upon successful completion of the EMT-Basic program, students shall be eligible to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians practical and written exam to obtain licensure as an EMT within the State of Wisconsin. The performance of Western's EMT graduates are shown below.
